OPEN, NOVICE, FUTURITY CAMPDRAFT & CHALLENGE TERMS

- Campdrafts run under ASHS campdrafting rules.
- Challenges run under ASCA rules.
- Horses and owners only be eligible for prize money if ALL of the following conditions are complied with.
- **ALL competitors will need to be Current Financial Australian Stock Horse Society or ASCA members in order to compete at the campdraft (If Not Temporary Membership will need to be purchased prior to competing) Stockmans Challenge Competitors will require to have current ASCA Membership.**
- Horses must compete in the correct age category where specified. Verification of age must be supplied or determined if requested. A horse's birth date is taken as the 1st August.
- Any prize money will be paid to person nominating horse.
- The status of horse will change according to the highest status horse in the OPEN event.
- Scratchings 100% Refund if received before 8am 25th August after this date will forfeit the entire nomination fee.
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint in relation to an Event, must lodge the complaint in writing to the Secretary of the DDASHS Branch within one hour of the incident taking place. Refer Section 24 of the ASHS handbook. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by The DDASHS Branch, the \$50 fee is forfeited.
- All rules as per relevant associations must be adhered to at all times, Competitors responsibility to read and understand rules and regulations prior to competing.
- All competitors under 18 years must wear a skullcap at all times when mounted on the grounds.
- Stallions containment regulations to be adhered to.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter the program and/or any terms and conditions.
- Changes need to be to the secretary's office within 2hrs hour of event starting.
- Darling Downs Rider awards are for Active Members of the Darling Downs ASHS Branch
- Corona Cup Award is for DDASHS active branch members only.
- Open Challenge Incentive for horses who been through Dalby Sale since 2010, can have changed ownership please notify office staff if your horse is eligible for the DDASHS to check their records.
- In the event that your power arrangement causes fault to the electrical supply and requires an electrician to visit the grounds the person responsible for the fault may be responsible for paying the electrician should it be deemed that your power arrangements were negligent.
- **Medical Service Provider - COUNTRY STYLE FIRST AID**
- All Competitors will need to complete a horse health declaration. This will need to be handed to the secretary's office.
- All competitors will need to present to the secretary's office to receive a competitors armband. This will be provided once confirmation of all paperwork including payment of nominations, current memberships, horse health declarations and COVID compliance. A competitor will not be able to enter the camp or challenge arena without this armband

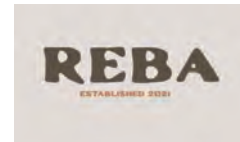
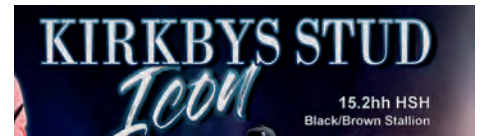

DECLARATION BY OWNER OR PERSON IN CHARGE OF HORSE/S ATTENDING

I _____ declare that the horse/s named above has/have been in good health, eating normally and not shown signs of illness during the last 3 days leading up to this event. I give my authorisation for the Event Organising Committee/Manager to call for veterinary inspection of the horse/s named above and in my care should they be showing signs of illness at any time during the course of the event. I agree to pay any veterinary fees incurred for the above mentioned horse/s as a result of this veterinary examination.

I agree to ensure that:

- All horses will be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry, and their hooves will be picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo.
- All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horses will be cleaned to remove all solid material that could contain disease agents, and then disinfected.
- As a Queensland horse owner, the procedures outlined in the Queensland Biosecurity Manual have been undertaken to reduce the risk of spreading cattle ticks and the horse/s are tick free.

I further declare that:

- The information contained in this Biosecurity Declaration is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
- I agree to abide by all conditions that may be imposed at any time by the Event Organising Committee/Manager.
- I acknowledge that in failure to comply, I may be directed to leave and my nominations will be forfeited.
- I acknowledge that decontamination and disinfection procedures may be required of me if instructed by the Event Organising Committee/Manager.
- I acknowledge that there is a possibility that horses might become infected with disease agents as a result of any movements and if necessary horses and premises will be quarantined in accordance with any Legislation covering such occurrences including policies and procedures in effect at that time. I agree and acknowledge that the Manager/Event Organising Committee, it's State or National Affiliated bodies and their members are not in any way liable for any cost, expense, loss, damage, claim, action, proceeding or other liability incurred by or made against me as a result of any movement of horses to the Event.
